**RESOLUTION ADOPTING ALL-MAILED BALLOT PROCEDURES FOR  
CONDUCTING SPECIAL DISTRICT ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is cost effective to conduct elections by all-mailed ballot; and

WHEREAS, sections 4002 and 4108 of the Elections Code allows a special district to conduct its elections totally by mailed ballot; and

WHEREAS, section 1500 of the Elections Code sets for the date the all-mailed ballot election is to be held; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 4104 of the Elections Code, at the first general district election conducted by all-mailed ballot the following question shall be printed on the ballot: "Shall the mailed ballot be used to conduct all future general district elections?"; and

WHEREAS, section 4003 of the Elections Code authorizes the governing board to revoke the all-mailed ballot procedure in specific circumstances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all future general district elections shall be conducted by all-mailed ballot unless otherwise determined by the governing board in accordance with the Election Laws of the State of California.
